

Privacy Statement

Worcester County 4-H Center, Inc at Camp Marshall collects personally identifiable information, such as your email address, name, home or work address or telephone number. The Worcester County 4-H Center, Inc Camp Marshall also collects anonymous demographic information, which is not unique to you, such as your ZIP code, age, gender, preferences, interests and favorites.

There is also information about your computer hardware and software that is automatically collected by Camp Marshall. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring Web site addresses. This information is used by Camp Marshall for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the Camp Marshall website.

Camp Marshall will use your information to mail or email you promotional material pertaining to our programs. If you provide us with personal information as a potential staff member, your information may be used in carrying out our reference and background checks as a part of our staff hiring process.

If you register for summer camp online, the information will be used to register a child for summer camp and to collect payment information to pay for the child's registration. Email addresses provided on the registration form will be used to communicate information about programs and events throughout the year so we stay connected with you and your family. No information you provide us will be passed on to any advertisers or third parties outside Camp Marshall.

For children under the age of 13: In compliance with the Child Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA) you must ask your parents to give your personal information online.
